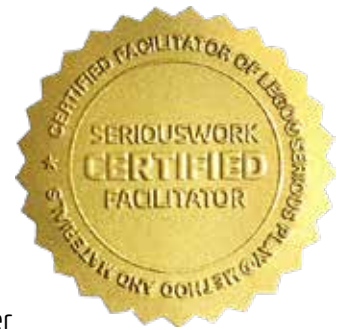

- To facilitate your first workshop
- To reflect on skills acquired and gain certification

What we cover

On Day 1 we learn about the LEGO Serious Play facilitation fundamentals and how to give your workshop participants the skills to use LEGO Serious Play.



We learn and practice Build Level 1: Individual Model Building (the foundation of every LEGO Serious Play workshop) before progressing to Build Level 2: Shared Model Building. We give you an overview and case study of Build Level 3 and then show you how you can use LEGO Serious Play in team building.

On Day 2 we learn from case studies, we cover the preparation phase, advise on bricks and cover intellectual property. We then practice shared model building and equip you to prepare for, design and deliver LEGO Serious Play workshops. By the end of the day you will have facilitated your first workshop. Afterwards we reflect, celebrate and present you with your certificate.

The key difference from other courses is that SeriousWork gives participants LEGO Serious Play *facilitation* skills. Our course is practice based, by the time you graduate you will have the skills and confidence to use the method in workshops of your own.
